

# Major Damages/Expenses from Flood

<b>Hunting Island State Park</b>	\$6,500,000.00	Re-nourishment, road/parking repairs, water line repairs, campsite repairs	FEMA
<b>Santee State Park</b>	\$450,000.00	Road repairs, dam repairs, utility repairs	FEMA
<b>Sesquicentennial State Park</b>	\$250,000.00	Road repairs, facility repairs due to water damage, fill dirt for eroded areas	FEMA
<b>Hickory Knob State Park</b>	\$100,000.00	Cabin destroyed, have filed with insurance	FEMA/Insurance
<b>Hampton Plantation State Historic Site</b>	\$20,000.00	Purchase of fill dirt for road repairs	FEMA
<b>Givhans Ferry State Park</b>	\$15,000.00	sand to repair eroded beach	FEMA
<b>Poinsett State Park</b>	\$15,000.00	Spillway repairs	FEMA
